

# 2020-2021 Waste & Waste Diversion Calendar

Garbage collection will occur weekly, on Tuesdays, with a weight limit of 44 lbs/20 kg per bag. Recycling collection will occur weekly, on Thursdays, with Fibre/Paper and Mixed Containers on alternating weeks. Yard Waste pick-up will occur on the last Wednesday of the month from April to November. Large Item pick-up, for the green and orange tags, will occur on Monday, May 11, 2020, and on Monday, October 5, 2020. Large Item pick-up, for the blue, red, and white tags, will occur on Wednesday, May 13, 2020, and Wednesday, October 7, 2020. **On Nov 1, drop off your pumpkins at the Kinsmen Amphitheatre for the annual Prescott Pumpkin Parade.** Please refer to the Large Item and Recycling guide on the reverse side of the pick-up calendar. **Garbage and Recycling must be placed on the curbside before 7 a.m. on the pick-up date.**

## List of Large Pick-up Items (occurs twice per year)

**GREEN AND ORANGE TAGS**  
(Monday, May 11 & Monday, October 5)

### GREEN: COST \$10.00

Items include: Furniture and household items such as lamps, tables, chairs, sofas, dressers, etc.

### ORANGE: COST \$20.00

Items include: Mattresses and box springs.

**NOTE:** Coloured tags are available for purchase at the Municipal Building, 360 Dibble Street West, from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday.

### LIMIT OF 4 PER HOUSEHOLD

Tags will include a place for name and address to ensure proper use of the tags and prevent theft of tags once placed at the curb. Last days for ticket purchases are Friday, May 8 and Friday, October 2 respectively.

**Treasure Exchange Day** will occur on Saturday, September 19, 2020. Residents are encouraged to place their unneeded items, in good, clean condition, out to the curb clearly marked free. Tour the Town to find new-to-you treasures!

**Community Yard Sale Day** will occur on May 23, 2020. Please submit your address to [operations@prescott.ca](mailto:operations@prescott.ca) by Friday, May 15, to be included in a yard sale map for the day. Find map on our social media channels and in print within the South Grenville Journal.

**Christmas Tree Pick-Up** will occur between January 4, 2021 to January 8, 2021. Trees must be free of ornaments, and placed neatly at the curb. Artificial trees not collected.

**BLUE, RED AND WHITE TAGS**  
(Wednesday, May 13 & Wednesday, October 7)

### BLUE: COST \$15.00

Items include: Stoves, washing machines, dryers, dishwashers, furnaces, hot water tanks, microwaves, sinks, bathtubs, water softeners, water heaters, barbecues, and any items deemed eligible by the Director of Operations.

### RED: COST \$50.00

Items include: All Freon supplied household items, such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, de-humidifiers, and any other Freon use appliances.

### WHITE: COST FREE

Items include: Computers, computer accessories, laptops, monitors, stereos, disk players, fax machines, television, DVD & VCR players, telephones and all other electronic items as deemed eligible by the Director of Operations. Tires and rims (tires must be removed from the rim).

### Yard Waste

Depending on volumes, yard waste pick-up may extend over multiple days. Compost must be placed at the curb in paper bags (plastic bags are not accepted). Addresses with branches and brush must be registered with the Operations Department by the Friday prior to yard waste pick-up. Weather conditions may effect pick-up. Compost site is open from mid April - mid November.
