EXPLORE

Prescott

On the shores of the St. Lawrence River, a short drive from Ottawa, Kingston, and Brockville, Prescott is the lively port town you don't see coming. Historic streets, unique shops and dining in Downtown Prescott, a walkable shoreline, and an active events calendar come together to surprise first-time visitors and bring people back to #ExplorePrescottON.

Downtown Prescott is the town's heritage core, anchored by historic King Street—part of Ontario Highway 2 and lined with shops, cafés, and restaurants. A short stroll away, the waterfront features Centennial Park's splash pad and Kelly's Bay beach, plus green spaces and walking paths leading to the Sandra S. Lawn Harbour & Marina, often without losing sight of the River. Boaters, paddlers, and touring vessels make Prescott a Port of Call, while scuba divers explore shipwrecks at the local dive park.

Along the shore, the colourful Prescott Pop-Ups form a village of seasonal shops, artisans, food trucks, and patios. Nearby, self-guided tours of the Rotary Lighthouse reveal panoramic views of the harbour, islands, and national historic sites. Fort Wellington invites visitors to step into history with interpretation, hands-on exhibits, and seasonal programming.

Prescott's calendar celebrates sport, arts, and community. The King Street Promenade turns Downtown Prescott into a pedestrian street festival, while the Prescott Ribfest & Sportsman Show fills

the waterfront with barbecue and family fun each June. The Farmers' & Crafters' Market highlights growers and makers, and the Kinsmen Amphitheatre hosts concerts and the St. Lawrence Shakespeare Festival overlooking the river in July and August.

Many visitors extend their stay and use Prescott as a base for exploring South Grenville. Accommodation ranges from historic inns and B&Bs to the new Quality Inn & Suites, with easy access to nearby highways. A marina and deep-water dock make it simple for boaters to tie up and walk straight into Downtown Prescott, while Prescott's Ontario By Bike designation makes it equally welcoming for cyclists.

With free transient docking, convenient parking, and a downtown steps from the St. Lawrence, Prescott delivers far more than you'd expect from a small riverside town.

Plan an afternoon, a weekend, or a longer stay— and surprise yourself in Prescott.

Augusta Township

Welcome to Augusta Township, where history, nature, and small-town charm come together along the beautiful St. Lawrence River.

Augusta Township is a welcoming community that honours its rich past while looking confidently toward the future. Whether you are here for a day, a weekend, or choose to put down roots, you will find plenty to explore.

Discover iconic landmarks like the historic Blue Church, cherished since 1845. Just nearby stands the privately owned Maitland Tower, originally built as a windmill and later redesigned into a distillery, alongside beautifully restored heritage buildings, some dating back to 1828. The Township is also home to a historic library housed in a former schoolhouse built in 1833, a structure that still stands today and continues to serve the community as a place of learning, connection, and pride. Together, these sites offer striking reminders of the area's early industrial, architectural, and cultural legacy.

Augusta Township offers a supportive environment for local businesses. Whether providing unique services or pursuing new entrepreneurial initiatives, businesses benefit from a community that encourages growth. Among the local offerings is Maison Maitland, where visitors can book culinary experiences and accommodations along the St. Lawrence River. Other local businesses, ranging from artisanal producers to innovative service providers, further illustrate the diversity of opportunities for investment and entrepreneurship throughout the Township.

Residents and visitors enjoy a wide range of outdoor recreation opportunities. With more than 180 km of trails weaving through Limerick Forest, you can hike, bike, ski, or snowmobile through breathtaking landscapes. Explore the Rothesay Dive Site and its famed century-old shipwreck, or unwind with birdwatching, photography, and peaceful picnics in nature. Recreational amenities also include pickle ball courts and the popular year-round outdoor rink in Maynard, offering space for skating, hockey, and community gatherings in every season.

Augusta Township is proud to host vibrant annual events that bring neighbours and visitors together, including the beloved North Augusta Labour Day Festival and the Annual Firefighters Association Pancake Supper held each April in support of the Augusta Township Firefighter's Association. Additional seasonal gatherings throughout the year offer even more reasons to visit and celebrate our community spirit. Five recreational community hubs provide welcoming spaces to connect, play, and enjoy local activities year-round.

With an excellent school, family-friendly parks, a historic library, and a dedicated network of community services, Augusta Township is not only a great place to visit, it is a wonderful place to call home.

Edwardsburgh Cardinal

The Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal offers many wonderful sights, activities and adventures for visitors of all ages. Explore the area and discover the township's rich place in history with heritage sites and experiences that will take you hundreds of years into the past.

Visit the Spencerville Mill and Museum, an actual grist mill constructed in the early 1800s. In the midst of beautiful parks and the South Nation River, the Mill is nestled into the charming historical downtown Spencerville. Grab lunch from a local restaurant and enjoy a picnic lunch surrounded by the history of this village. Spencerville comes alive for many special events throughout the year. Every September, the Spencerville Fair welcomes thousands to join this celebration of agriculture.

Just minutes from the Prescott-Ogdensburg bridge connecting the Township to the USA, you'll find the Battle of the Windmill - a National Historic site in New Wexford. Walk the winding pathways of this site and climb to the top of the lighthouse for stunning views of the seaway, or explore the boardwalk near the Port of Johnstown for the best photos of the international bridge.

Our waterfront provides a wealth of recreational opportunities along the St. Lawrence River. Boating and canoeing allow for beautiful and unique

interactions with nature, while fishing finds countless species of freshwater fish. Take advantage of Cardinal's boat launch, docks, volleyball and horseshoe pits with front row seats to international ships passing by.

The Galop Canal and historic shipwrecks of the St. Lawrence Seaway are commemorated with plaques you can find throughout the Village of Cardinal. Scuba dive in one of the clearest freshwater settings in the entire world, allowing you to discover a variety of challenges and rewards, ranging from basic exploration to advanced shipwreck exploration. There are two shipwrecks in Cardinal for divers to explore, the Conestoga and the Wee Hawk. You can even see the top of the Conestoga breaching the water line from the shore! Cyclists can take advantage of the Great Lakes Waterfront Trail, a 3600km signed trail connecting Canada's Great lakes to the St. Lawrence River.

Only an hour from Ottawa, Cornwall, or Kingston, and just across the river from Ogdensburg, USA, Edwardsburgh Cardinal is the perfect place to stop when travelling in Eastern Ontario and South Grenville.

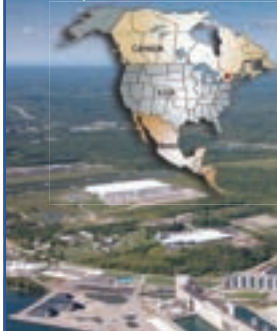

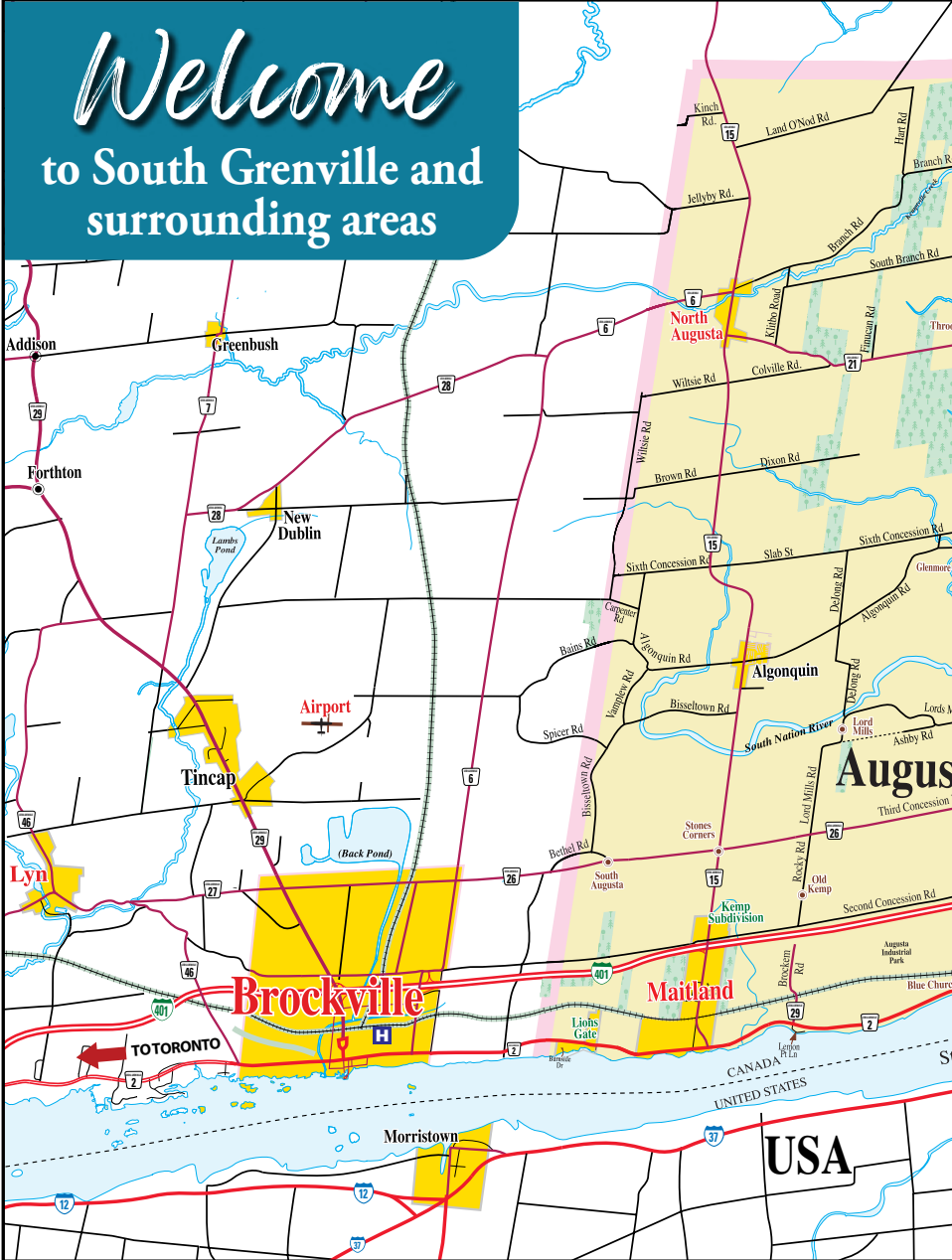

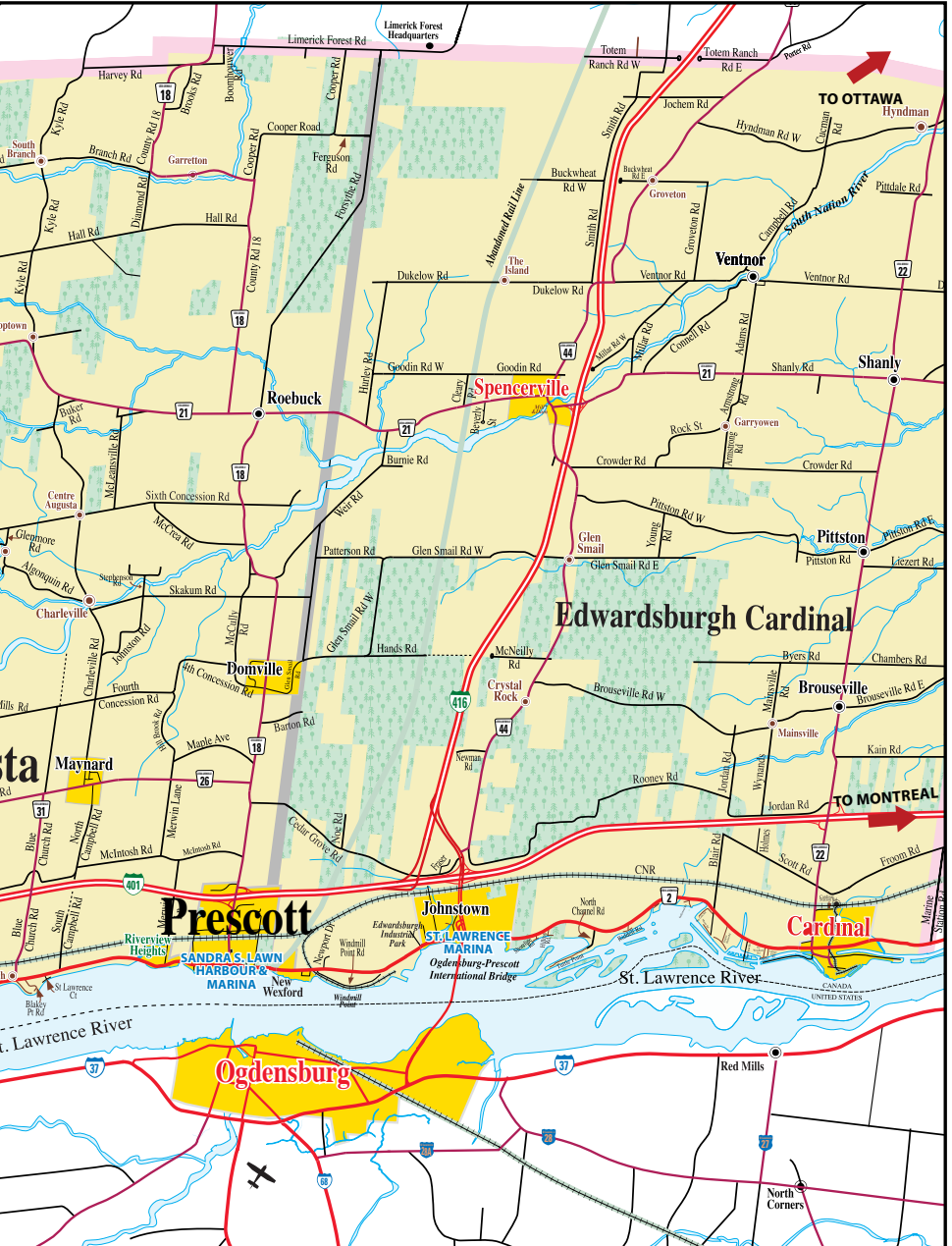


Located on the shores of the beautiful St. Lawrence River, a top-notch 128-slip marina is located within the Sandra S. Lawn Harbour.

A Journey Through History:

1 **Battle of the Windmill** Windmill Point Road, New Wexford Open Mid June - Labour Day Weekend pc.gc.ca

Overlooking the St. Lawrence River is the red roofed stone windmill, a scene of a turning point in Canadian history with the invading fore of American "Hunters" doing battle with British soldiers in the fight for Upper Canada.



2 **Fort Wellington** 370 Vankoughnet Street, Prescott | 613-925-2896 pc.gc.ca/wellington

One of the best preserved nineteenth-century fortifications in Canada, Fort Wellington presents the strategic importance of the St. Lawrence River prior, during and after the War of 1812. Immerse yourself into historic accounts of war, peace, rebellion, and cooperation.



3 **Grenville County Historical Society** 500 Railway Avenue, Prescott | 613-925-0489 grenvillecountyarchives.ca

Experienced volunteers have organized a large library of books, maps, newspapers, land records, slides relating to the history of the Grenville area.



4 **Maitland Tower** Hwy. 2, Maitland | 613-302-1676 maitlandtower.ca

Built by George Longley in 1828, it was originally the second largest flour mill in Upper Canada. The tower remains as the shell of the original windmill and serves as a reminder of the area's history, including the Borst and Halladay Distillery. This distillery was notably forced to close for bootlegging by Sir John A. Macdonald. Please contact property owner, Philip Ling to view the historical property.



5 **Museum & Visitor Centre** 202 Water Street, Prescott | 613-925-2812 Open Year Round Wednesday - Saturday prescott.ca/recreation-culture/museum-visitor-centre

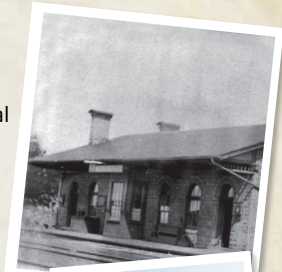

Prescott Railway Station

Designated a national historic site in 1973 it is a typical example of the smaller stations erected for the Grand Trunk Railway. Influenced by English designs, the station is an enduring monument to early Canadian railway enterprise.

Prescott Rotary Lighthouse

The Rotary Lighthouse's lantern, originally mounted atop the Dominion Lighthouse Depot just east of today's Canadian Coast Guard Base, features a Fresnel lens and other navigational aids once used to train lighthouse keepers from across Canada. Visitors can take self-guided tours to the top and explore the history of the waterfront through interpretive panels located on the 2nd and 3rd floors.

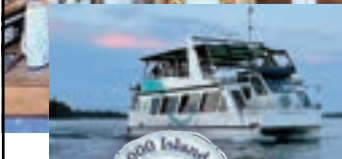
