√ FIBRE AND PAPER

- Boxboard (cereal, tissue boxes remove liners, flatten)
- Cardboard & tubes (flatten, bundle if large)
- Calendars, glossy flyers, posters
- Clean paper shopping bags or paper packaging
- Paper egg cartons
- Envelopes, junk mail, newspapers
- Magazines, catalogues, telephone books (No hardcover books)

√ MIXED CONTAINERS

- Empty aerosol cans (hairspray, cooking spray)
- Aluminum foil, trays, plates (washed and clean)
- Plastic egg cartons
- Cans (steel and aluminum)
- Glass bottles, jars, jugs
- Plastic ice cream containers
- Plastic bottles, jars, jugs, bleach bottles, pails, tubs
- Shampoo, conditioner, soap, cleaning bottles
- Windshield washer containers (All containers must be empty and rinsed)

Pre-register your items before the deadline above, by calling 613-925-2812 x 6200. Place registered items curbside at 7:00am on the collection date. Consider donating usable items before disposal.

GREEN: \$10.00

Furniture and household items such as lamps, tables, chairs, sofas, dressers, etc.

ORANGE: \$20.00

Mattresses and box springs.

BLUE: \$15.00

Stoves, washing machines, dryers, dishwashers, furnaces, hot water tanks, microwaves, sinks, bathtubs, water softeners, barbeques (remove propane tanks).

RED: \$65.00

All freon supplied household items; refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers.

☐ WHITE: FREE

Electronic waste items such as: Flat-screen and tube televisions, computer monitors, laptops and desktop computers, tablets and e-readers, printers and fax machines, DVD/Blu-ray players and gaming consoles, stereo systems and speakers and small electronics (keyboards, mice, cables, chargers). Tires and rims – rims must be removed from tires before collection.

SOLID WASTE

Garbage bags should not exceed **90L** (**32.5"x30"**) with a maximum weight of **44lbs per bag**. Attach one garbage tag to the top of each bag. Tags can be purchased at multiple businesses in town, including Town Hall, 360 Dibble Street West.

YARD WASTE

The town accepts grass clippings, sods, plant remains, wood chippings, branches under 6" wide, brush and leaves in paper bags only.

Muncipal Yard Waste Facility Hours

Open April 14, 2026 on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 10:00am-2:00pm and Saturdays from 8:00am-4:00pm. Closed November 28, 2026 for the season. Hired contractors are able to access the site with the purchase of a site pass. See website for more details.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Drop-off dates are facilitated by the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville. For more info, visit www.leedsgrenville.com or call 613-342-3840 Ext 2413. Drop-off dates to be released the first week of April and can be found on the town's website.
