ALL ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY AND CLEAN

FIBRE AND PAPER	MIXED CONTAINERS
<p><b>All boxboard must be broken down; that which does not fit in the recycling container must be bundled.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Boxboard (cereal, tissue boxes, liner removed)</li> <li>▪ Calendars, glossy flyers, posters</li> <li>▪ Cardboard, cardboard tubes</li> <li>▪ Clean paper shopping bags or paper packaging</li> <li>▪ Paper egg cartons</li> <li>▪ Envelopes, junk mail, newspapers</li> <li>▪ Household paper, magazines, catalogues, telephone books</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Empty aerosol cans (empty) (hairspray, cooking spray)</li> <li>▪ Aluminum foil, trays, plates (washed and clean)</li> <li>▪ Plastic egg cartons</li> <li>▪ Cans (steel and aluminum)</li> <li>▪ Glass (bottles, jars, jugs)</li> <li>▪ Plastic ice cream containers</li> <li>▪ Plastic bottles, plastic jars, jugs, bleach bottles, pails, tubs</li> <li>▪ Shampoo, conditioner, soap, cleaning bottles</li> <li>▪ Windshield washer containers</li> </ul>

Attach one garbage tag to the top of each bag. Tags can be purchased at multiple businesses in town, including Town Hall, 360 Dibble Street West.</p>
<p>Pre-register your items before the deadline above, by calling 613-925-2812 x 6200. Place registered items curbside at 7:00am on the collection date.</p> <p><b>GREEN: \$10.00</b> Furniture and household items such as lamps, tables, chairs, sofas, dressers, etc.</p> <p><b>ORANGE: \$20.00</b> Mattresses and box springs.</p> <p><b>BLUE: \$15.00</b> Stoves, washing machines, dryers, dishwashers, furnaces, hot water tanks, microwaves, sinks, bathtubs, water softeners, barbeques.</p> <p><b>RED: \$65.00</b> All freon supplied household items; refrigerators, freezers, air conditioner, and dehumidifiers.</p> <p><b>WHITE: FREE</b> Computers, laptops, monitors, stereos, disk players, fax machines, televisions, DVD/VCR players, telephones. Tires and rims. *Rims must be removed from the tires to be collected.</p>	YARD WASTE
<p><b>ELECTRONIC WASTE DAY (No Fee)</b> Friday, May 16, 2025 from 12:00pm-4:00pm at the Leo Boivin Community Centre <a href="https://www.com2recycling.com/">https://www.com2recycling.com/</a> </p>	<p>The town accepts grass clippings, sods, plant remains, wood chippings, branches under 6" wide, brush and leaves in paper bags only.</p> <p><b>Municipal Yard Waste Facility Hours</b> Open April 15, 2025 on Tuesdays &amp; Thursdays from 10:00am-2:00pm and Saturdays from 8:00am-4:00pm. Closed November 29, 2025 for the season. Hired contractors are able to access the site with the purchase of a site pass. See website for more details.</p>
